

Timeline for NACD Proposed Resolutions

- Proposed resolutions to NACD need to follow a prescribed time line and vetting process.
- All districts can submit such resolutions commencing at the spring regional meetings (North, Central and South).
- Upon initial announcement at those respective meetings -- an initial vote for action will take place consisting of the individuals from that region (a quorum will be needed in order for the resolution to be approved).
- A resolution(s) approved at the regional meeting will then be reviewed by the NJACD leadership group to finalize specific language and to ensure the action(s) proposed fits within the scope of NACD guidelines.
- Once NJACD review has been completed and said resolution(s) approved -- a copy will then be distributed to all NJ soil districts for their review and comments.
- Comments will be accepted up to two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled NJACD Annual Meeting in the Fall.
- The district proposing the resolution will have an opportunity to discuss the reasons for the resolution during the business meeting at the NJACD Annual Meeting.
- A final vote will then be in order to for either acceptance, rejection or tabling.
